

**INSURANCE BUSINESS (CONTROL) REGULATIONS
(COLLECTION OF SUPPLEMENTS TO PREMIUMS
PROHIBITED) 5743-1983**

By virtue of my powers under section 38 of the Insurance Business (Control) Law 5741-1941 I make these Regulations:

Collection of supplements to premiums prohibited

1. (a) An insurance contract shall not include any provision that obligates the insured person to pay a supplement to the basic insurance premiums, in respect of risks, conditions or benefits to which the insured person is entitled by virtue of any enactment.
- (b) In these regulations, "basic insurance premiums" - premiums in respect of the risks included in the insurance contract, other than risks added to the policy at the insured person's option.
